1. Event is for Rods & Customs that are 1969 & older.
2. Rods & Customs must meet the Wheels of Time 100 Point rules.
3. All vehicles need to be street legal. Proof of insurance and current state registration will be required upon request.
4. Registrations will be available at the show. You will not be turned away.
5. Pre-register! Forms must be received by July 21, 2009.

Remember: There is a \$10 surcharge for a returned check.

Remember: Do not send registrations via registered mail.

Event

1. Park will close at 7:00 PM on Wednesday and all cars must be removed from Park.

1. Park will re-open at 7:00 AM on Thursday for walk-ins only. Saving spaces will be permitted at this time in designated areas. Do not use ropes, stakes, chains or any other tripping hazard to save spaces. Please be considerate and respect the comfort of your neighbor. Canopies should not exceed twelve (12) foot in length or width. All canopies should be anchored to ground and taken down during windy conditions.

2. Gates will open for cars and registration at 2:00 PM on Thursday unless directed

earlier by Macungie Borough Police for safety reasons. (This happened the last 3 years).

3. Gates will open at 7:00 AM on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Registration will open at 8:00 AM. Registration will close at 5:00 PM on Friday and Saturday and 12:00 PM on Sunday.

4. Your vehicle must be on the park grounds on Sunday to be eligible for Sunday's Grand Prizes Drawing.

5. You must wear your participant buttons to get into the park each day.
6. No open fires are permitted. Tabletop propane grills are okay.
7. Operating motorized carts, scooters, pedal cars, bar stools, etc. is prohibited in the park with the exception of qualified vehicles for handicapped persons with Disability/Severely Disabled Veteran parking placards.
8. No skateboards, roller blades, or bikes are permitted in the park.
9. Pets are not permitted in the park.
10. Respect .NO PARKING. signs in Borough. Violators will be ticketed by Police.
